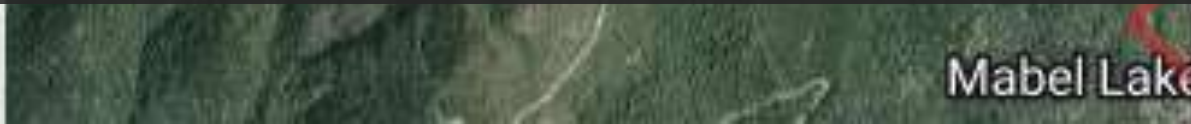

Cultural Heritage Assessments (CHA's)

- Field Review which considers impacts to water, wildlife habitat, plants, medicines etc.

Preliminary Field Reconnaissance (PFR's)

- Non-permitted field review to assess the potential for archaeological sites and may lead to recommendations for AIA's.

Challenges

- Current referral and consultation processes keep us reactive to the development that is occurring in Splatsin area of caretaker responsibility
- We do not receive funding for referral reviews- funding does go to the Splatsin Development Corporation for field review work on specific projects/developments.
- Time and capacity. Our department is project funded and those take priority.
- Referrals are generally driven by economic projects and there often isn't space created to address the cumulative impacts of development.
