

Engage First Nations early on in the process

Outlined in the Shuswap Trail Alliance Strategy

Important for developing relationships

Shuswap Trail Alliance meetings bring people together

Include all pertinent information, such as kmls, reports

Analysis and Response re. Land Stewardship

LSLB Archaeology, Cultural Heritage, Environmental

Archaeology:

RAAD (archaeology sites & potential)

Google Earth (slope, drainage, aspect)

LSLB Cultural Heritage: CKK, research

Environmental: Key Issues (pest management, salmon, caribou)

LSLB Current Referrals Process

- 1. Receive notification re. Crown Lands & Water Act
 BC & Federal Govt (SWAP, mail, email etc)
 Licensees (Forestry etc)
 Proponents (Recreational etc)
 Property Owners (ie. development on archaeology sites)
- 2. Ask for missing files (ie. kml/kmz), respond to those out of territory immediately, acknowledge receipt
 - 3. Put it in the calendar
 - 4. Analyze- Using RAAD, Google Earth, LSLB CKK etc
- 5. Send response-request action (meeting, site visit) or not

*Incoming referrals and follow up are constantly ongoing

*Developing prior relationships with First Nations is key

*Consider your relationship with First Nations a partnership

*View your relationship with First Nations as an opportunity

*Remember that capacity and time can be an issue for First Nations




