PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Parks and Recreation Plan is a roadmap to ensure that the CSRD's parks and recreation services **meet emerging community needs** and **support long-term wellbeing for residents** across the region.

The plan will:

- Review existing parks, and indoor and outdoor recreation amenities and services, and assess gaps and needs
- Help set priorities and determine where money should be invested
- Plan for growth to ensure that parks and recreation services keep up with evolving needs
