

About the Trails

Scotch Creek Hlina Lookout Trail

- Located in the North Shuswap Access from Scotch Creek Hlina FSR
- ✤ "More to Most Difficult" Rating
- ✤ Trail Distance 3.5 6 km (round trip with the Hlina Loop)
- Trail Activities: hiking, mountain biking, snowshoeing.

Mt Baldy Lookout Trail

- Located in the South Shuswap Access from South Shore Place and Elson Road, Sorrento
- ✤ Mostly "More Difficult" Rating
- Trail Distance 3.3 km (one way to lookout) 7.6 km return via upper loop
- Trail Activities: hiking, mountain biking, snowshoeing.



Damage Assessment Overview

- Assessment Goals and Objectives
 - To understand the extent and severity of wildfire damage to trail systems
 - Describe, Quantify, and Map the Impacts
 - To develop trail restoration/ repair recommendations
 - Describe and map the needed trail repairs to restore use to the full range of recreation activities

Assessment Approach

- Designed a Damage Survey Form (ESRI Survey123)
- Assessed trail systems based on all recreational trail use activities (hiking, mountain biking, snowshoeing, etc.)
- Compiled assessment results
- Prepared report and maps describing trail restoration/ repair strategies

- Clearing trails of downed trees, vulnerability in gullies
- Replacing damaged boardwalks
- Consider possible new routes to avoid reconstruction on steep slopes
- ✤ Repair livestock fencing
